Anthem Breach Largest to Date - 80 Million People Affected

America's second biggest health insurer, Anthem Inc., disclosed that they experienced a data breach that affected approximately 80 million people on February 4, 2015. Anthem disclosed that the breach exposed customers and employees' names, birth dates, Social Security numbers, and addresses.

Anthem has had a history of breaches in the past. "In 2011, Anthem settled with the Attorney General's office in Indiana for \$100,000 for failing to report a security breach in a timely manner, and in October 2012, settled with the California Attorney General's office for \$150,000, for the same violation. Based upon their history of failures in protecting sensitive health data and in complying with the state and federal notification obligations, as well as the magnitude of this breach, it likely that they will be subject to even stronger enforcement this time around." according to Joan Antokol, Managing Partner at Park Legal LLC.
