Surprising Health Benefits of Honey

Ancient Egyptians offered honey to the gods and joined the Romans, Greeks and Chinese in using it for wounds and healing. Today, many claim honey has miraculous healing properties. But just how much of honey's positive effects have been proven by science?



- 1. **Sore Throat Soother** A study done on 139 children found that honey does a better job at easing nighttime coughs and enhancing sleep than both the cough suppressant dextromethorphan and the antihistamine diphenhydramine (Benadryl). Honey should never be given to children under one.
- 2. Enhances Athletic Performance Studies from the University of Memphis revealed that honey is just as good, or even better, than sugar, glucose or water, in boosting endurance in athletes.
- 3. **Antibacterial Properties** Studies have shown that honey has the power to kill bacteria. It's effective against strains of E. coli and salmonella. A specific type of honey from New Zeland called manuka has been shown to fight staph and the digestive bacteria responsible for ulcers.
- 4. **Cancer, Heart Disease, Diabetes** Tualang honey has been found to play a role in regulating blood glucose and disrupt breast, cervical and skin cancer cells. More research is needed, but honey appears promising in fighting cancer, heart disease and diabetes.
