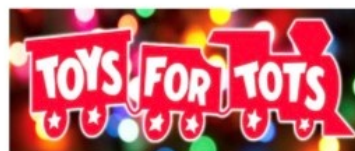
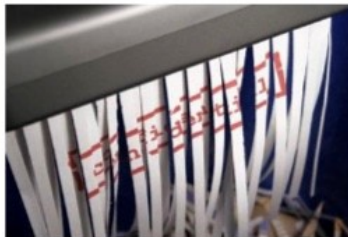

Tips for a successful Shred Event!

- Plan it on a Saturday when people are not at work.
- Advertise, advertise, advertise! We found our clients' success is directly related to the marketing they do. Consider taking out an ad in the local newspaper, advertising on social media, enlisting radio and tv, and mailing post cards to clients or prospective clients.
- Limit it to 2-3 boxes per person. And, if people have more, consider charging \$10-\$20/box to donate to a charity of your choice.

Scary Places Your Data Can Hide

Personal data can be found in some odd places you may not think of. These threats can subject you to identify theft or a data breach. And, they are probably in your office or home right now!



- **Wi-Fi** - Wireless network access means any employee or house guest within range can access data on the network. Make sure you are password protected and that you reset the password regularly. Using encryption is even safer.
- **Cables** - Did you know phone chargers are actually devices? That's because cables are transmission devices. Look around your office to see how many employees use their workstation to charge their phones. This is a potential catastrophe. It's better not to allow employees to charge phones at their work station.
- **Printers** - Most printers are Internet and network connected. They store what they printed. Most models, with the exception of very expensive ones, have minimal security. Be careful for leased printers. Don't just return them without being sure the memory is destroyed. And, if you are a smaller company or residential consumer with a lower end printer, make sure at the end of its lifespan, you take it to a certified company to destroy the memory containing devices.
