



An SEC filing made on April 4, 2022 by the company formerly known as Square reported that the Cash App was breached by a former employee.

They did not disclose how many customers were affected other than to say they had reached 8 million customers to inform them of the breach.

Customers names, account numbers and portfolio values was among the information leaked.
