Inside Contractor Breaches Florida Gulf Coast Business

The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) fined Gulf Coast Pain Consultants, which does business as Clearway Pain Solutions, \$1.19 million after it was revealed that an insider breach impacted 35,000 people.

Gulf Coast Pain reported that a contractor they engaged from May to August 2018 to provide business consulting services continued to access their medical records. The contractor was accessing the database in 2019 for fraudulent Medicare claims. The former contractor was later indicted.

The compromised data included patient names, addresses, phone numbers, e-mail addresses, Social Security numbers and other health information.


