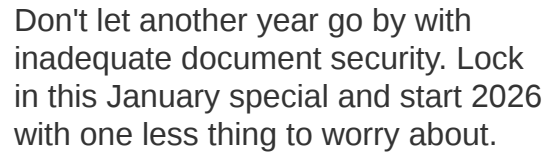

Why January Babies May Have a Brain Advantage

Fascinating new neuroscience research suggests that the month you're born in may influence your cognitive abilities in surprising ways, and January babies appear to have drawn a lucky card.

A comprehensive study from the Max Planck Institute analyzed brain development patterns in over 12,000 individuals and discovered that

For businesses preparing for tax season, now is the perfect time to shred outdated records from 2017 and earlier (most business tax documents need to be retained for seven years). Make sure you're working with a NAID AAA Certified shredding provider that offers on-site destruction and provides Certificates of Destruction—these certificates serve as proof of compliance should you ever face an audit or legal inquiry.

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people born in late autumn and early winter months showed enhanced activity in the brain's prefrontal cortex, the region responsible for executive function, planning, and self-control.

The reason? It's all about maternal vitamin D exposure during pregnancy. Mothers who are in their third trimester during summer months (for January babies) receive optimal sunlight exposure when the baby's brain is undergoing critical development. Vitamin D plays a crucial role in neural pathway formation, and those summer months provide the highest natural levels.

Additionally, January-born individuals were found to have statistically higher levels of dopamine receptors; potentially making them more resilient to stress and better at delayed gratification. The study also revealed an interesting correlation: January babies showed a 15% higher likelihood of pursuing creative careers compared to those born in spring months.

Of course, birth month isn't destiny—neuroplasticity means our brains continue developing throughout life. But it's a reminder of how interconnected our biology is with seasonal rhythms and environmental factors.

Security & Compliance: What the Updated Data Breach Notification Law Means for Your Business

Florida businesses need to pay close attention to recent updates in the state's data breach notification requirements. As of July 2024, amendments to Florida Statute 501.171 have tightened timelines and expanded the definition of what constitutes a breach requiring notification.

Under the updated law, businesses must now notify affected individuals within 30 days of determining that a breach has occurred—with no extensions available except under extraordinary circumstances approved by the Attorney General. This is a significant change from the previous statute, which allowed up to 60 days in certain situations.

The definition of "personal information" has also been expanded to include biometric data, health insurance policy numbers, and online credentials combined with security questions or answers. This means many more incidents now qualify as reportable breaches under Florida law.

For businesses in healthcare, financial services, or any industry handling sensitive client data, understanding your document destruction practices is critical to compliance. If a breach involves paper records that weren't properly destroyed, your business could face penalties under both Florida state law

and federal regulations like HIPAA or GLBA.

Florida Attorney General Ashley Moody has emphasized that her office will pursue enforcement actions against businesses that fail to implement "reasonable measures" to protect personal information. Proper document shredding, especially through a NAID AAA Certified provider, demonstrates the reasonable measures required by law.

The law also requires notification to the Florida Department of Legal Affairs if a breach affects 500 or more Florida residents. With Florida's population now exceeding 22 million, even small businesses can easily cross this threshold.

Protect your business by conducting regular security audits, implementing a formal document retention and destruction policy, and ensuring all team members understand which documents contain personal information that requires secure destruction.
